I think that we only had to close The Grove Cove two or three times this year due to rain or lightning. PLEASE NOTE: The Grove

Cove's last day of operation for the summer season will be on

Labor Day, Monday, September 5<sup>th</sup>.

Additionally, this is the time of year when children go back to school and start riding the bus again. Please be mindful and careful as you drive through the community as children don't always use crosswalks and can be difficult to see when darting out from in between cars. In consideration of future plantings, please be aware that anything that has grown to touch a building or railing surface is considered "overgrown vegetation" in the eyes of HUD. Please make sure that all future plantings are planted in a way that the foliage doesn't overhang sidewalks or designated pathways and said plants will not grow to touch the building or a railing's surface. Following these guidelines for plantings around your unit in the future will help all of us avoid untimely removal or pruning of your plants, flowers, and shrubs.

Lastly, I want to let the community know that the Maintenance Department is working their way through the last of the Preventative Maintenance Inspections and are planning on contacting you about the repairs noted during your inspection. It has been several years since we've been able to safely conduct Annual Inspections and accordingly, the list of repairs is significantly larger than previous years. Our plan is to make sure that all repairs noted during the inspection are addressed, but we ask for your patience as we work our way through scheduling the repairs for all 520 units here at Hanover Grove.

### **RECIPES**

#### Chicken Enchiladas



Prep: 15 Minutes

Cooke Time: 10 Minutes

Total Time: 25 Minutes



Prep: 5 Minutes

Chill Time: 1 Hour

Total: 1 Hour 5 Minutes

### Ingredients

- corn tortillas 14-16
- 1 can red enchilada sauce (14 ounce)
- 1/2 cup beef broth
- 1/2 tbsp honey
- cooked and shredded chicken (I use 2-3 chicken breasts depending on size)

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
- 2. In a small pot mix enchilada sauce, beef broth, and honey. Let it simmer for 10 minutes.
- 3. Pour a small layer of enchilada sauce mixture on the bottom of a 9x13 pan.
- 4. Heat your corn tortillas in the microwave until the are warm and flexible. If they are cracking when you try to roll them heat a little longer.
- 5. Spoon a small amount of sauce on one side of your corn tortilla. Add some chicken and cheese and roll up.
- 6. Once all of your tortillas are filled pour remaining sauce over your enchiladas. Sprinkle with cheese and cilantro. Bake for 10 minutes or until cheese is melted.

#### Easy Pineapple Dessert

### Ingredients

- 1 can (20 oz.) Crushed Pineapple in Juice, undrained
- 1 pkg. (3.4 oz.) Vanilla Flavor Instant Pudding
- 1 cup thawed Whipped Topping
- Maraschino cherries

#### **Directions**

- 1. Mix pineapple and dry pudding mix. Gently stir in whipped topping.
- 2. Top with remaining whipped topping and a cherry.
- 3. Refrigerate for an hour before serving.
- 4. Enjoy!


