


NEED TO VOTE BY PROXY:

Article IV, Section 8 of the Hanover Grove Cooperative Bylaws

"A Member may appoint as his/her proxy a member of his/her immediate family (as defined by the Board of Directors) or any other member as his/her proxy. In no case, may a member cast more than one vote by proxy in addition to his/her vote. The proxy holder must not be more than 30 days delinquent in housing charges to the Cooperative based on the books and records of the Cooperative. Any proxy must be filed with the Secretary before the appointed time of each meeting."

2022 PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION WORK SHEET

For the Calendar ending December 31st, **2022** real estate taxes paid at Hanover Grove Cooperative was paid from **9.51**% of the Carrying Charges collected by the Cooperative from all members. Therefore, each member who lived during the entire year of **2022** is eligible to claim **9.51**% of their total carrying charges paid as a deduction on their income taxes and/or as a credit for Homestead Property Taxes paid on your behalf. The following formula is to be used to determine the amount of deduction if you lived in the Cooperative for part of the year or did not pay all of your carrying charges assessed in **2022**.

• 0		Carrying Charges * You paid in 2022				Amount of deduction		
Real Estate Taxes	=	\$	X	.0951	=	\$		

*Carrying charges paid in **2022** are defined by the IRS as <u>only</u> carrying charges payments that you directly made. Do not include membership fees, late charges, and repair charges paid. Payment made by outside parties on your behalf (HUD or MSHDA) are also not allowed. Use only the portion you paid directly for carrying charges each month in this calculation.

Members who have <u>not</u> missed any payment for **2022**, or were not receiving subsidy, may use the chart below to calculate your applicable tax deduction.

RECIPES



Irish Potato Bites



Ingredients

- 20 red potatoes small, golf ball size
- ½ cup corned beef
- ¼ cup cheddar cheese shredded

• 1 tablespoon butter melted salt and sour cream for toppings, optional

Directions

- 1. Fill a large pot with water and bring to a boil
- 2. Add potatoes and boil until they are "tender", about 10 minutes.
- 3. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Once potatoes are cooked and have cooled, cut each one in half and cut a small slice off the rounded end so the potato can sit up on a flat surface.
- 4. Scoop out the inside of each potato half saving the potato insides in a bowl.
- 5. Add cheese, corned beef, and butter to the bowl with the saved potato insides and mix together until well combined. Salt the potato mixture to taste. Sprinkle some salt over the potato halves.
- 6. Scoop mixture into potato halves and then place them on a baking sheet lined with a silicone mat or parchment paper.
- 7. Place baking sheet in oven for 10 minutes.
- 8. Remove from oven and serve with a dollop of sour cream if desired.

Pot of Gold Cupcakes

Ingredients

- Cupcakes
- Blue Buttercream frosting (or green!)
- White Buttercream Frosting
- Piping Bag
- Pastry tip with 1/4 to 1/2 inch opening.
- Airheads Xtremes candy
- Rolos
- Gold Coarse Shimmer Sugar

Directions

- 1. Bake cupcakes via instructions on the box. Let cool and frost cupcakes with blue (or green) frosting. Pipe on fluffy white frosting with a 1/4 to 1/2 inch plain round pastry tip. Frosting needs to be stiff to help keep the candy rainbow in place. (can always substitute with marshmallows)
- 2. Cut Airhead Xtremes in half and place the ends into the white frosting. Add more white frosting if you want extra "clouds". Be sure to not cut the AirHead rainbow candy too long. This will make a saggy rainbow.
- 3. Pipe white frosting on the bottom of a Rolos candy. Dip the frosting in gold coarse sugar.
- 4. Place the candy pot of gold at the end of the rainbow.
- 5. Enjoy!


