

# **NOTICE:**

This month's Hanover Express, delivered on August 31, 2023, marks official notice of our intention to raise the monthly carrying charges beginning on November 1, 2023. It has been four (4) years since we have raised carrying charges and unfortunately, the cost of everything has risen during that time. The new "Basic" monthly carrying charge(s) are as follows

I noticed last autumn that many of the members here took the time to decorate their units for Halloween. While I do appreciate the spirit and effort put into making your place look festive for the upcoming holiday, it should be noted that <u>outdoor holiday decorations are not permitted until two (2)</u> <u>weeks before the holiday</u> per Hanover Grove's Rules and Regulations which state:

**110.23** The Board of Directors will permit decorations for specific holidays such as but not limited to the following: Easter, Independence Day (July 4<sup>th</sup>), Halloween, Thanksgiving, Hanukkah, and Christmas. For all holidays with the exception of Christmas, decorations will be permitted to go up two weeks before the holiday and must be removed within two weeks following the holiday. For Christmas, decorations may be put up following the Thanksgiving holiday and must be removed within thirty (30) days following the Christmas holiday. Any holiday not specified herein may have permitted decorations if it is a generally recognized or a religious holiday and the member formally requests permission from the Cooperative to decorate.



Failure to comply with the Rules and Regulations may result in an Administrative Enforcement Fee being added to your account and you may be asked to remove the decorations. That's all for this month. 

# Pumpkin Cake with Apple Cider Glaze

### Ingredients

- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 (15 oz) can pumpkin puree
- 1-1/2 cups confectioners' sugar
- 3 tbsps apple cider
- 3/4 tsp pumpkin pie spice

### Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.
- 2. Empty the contents of the boxed cake mix and pumpkin puree into a large bowl. Using a mixer, beat until well incorporated. The batter will be very thick.
- 3. Pour batter into a greased pan (using a 7 x 11 or chosen pan).

4. Bake for 28 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Do not overbake.

5. Let cool for 5-10 minutes in the pan, then flip onto platter.

#### Make the glaze while you're waiting:

1. Combine powdered sugar, apple cider, and pumpkin pie spice. Glaze should be thick but pourable. Add more sugar or cider if needed. Pour over the cake while still warm. Reserve some to pour over each slice when served.

### Shells with Roasted Cauliflower and Chickpeas

# Ingredients

- 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil, plus more for serving
- 1 head cauliflower (about 2 pounds), cut into florets
- 1 can (15.5 ounces) chickpeas, rinsed and drained
- Coarse salt and ground pepper
- 5 ounces crusty bread, cut into 1/2 inch pieces (2 cups)
- 1 pound medium shells
- 3 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley
- 1/2 cup fresh ricotta

# Directions

Cook Time: 35 Minutes

Total Time: 45 Minutes

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees, with racks in upper and lower thirds. On a rimmed baking sheet, toss together 2 tablespoons oil, cauliflower, and chickpeas; season with salt and pepper. Arrange cauliflower and chickpeas in a single layer and roast until cauliflower is tender and chickpeas are crunchy, 25 minutes. On another rimmed baking sheet, arrange bread in a single layer and toast until golden and crisp, 10 minutes.
- 2. Meanwhile, in a large pot of boiling salted water, cook pasta until al dente. Drain pasta and return to pot. Add cauliflower mixture, 2 tablespoons oil, and parsley. Season with salt and pepper and toss to combine. To serve, top with croutons and ricotta, then drizzle with oil.


