

Article IV, Section 8 of the Hanover Grove

Cooperative Bylaws

"A Member may appoint as his/her proxy a member of his/her immediate family (as defined by the Board of Directors) **or any other member as his/her proxy.** In no case, may a member cast <u>more than</u> <u>one</u> vote by proxy in addition to his/her vote. <u>The proxy holder must</u> <u>not be more than 30 days delinquent in housing charges to the</u> <u>Cooperative based on the books and records of the</u>

<u>Cooperative.</u> Any proxy must be filed with the Secretary before the appointed time of each meeting."

HANOVER GROVE COOPERATIVE

2024 PROPERTY TAX DEDUCTION WORKSHEET

For the Calendar ending December 31, **2024**, real estate taxes paid at Hanover Grove Cooperative were paid from 10.28% of the Carrying Charges collected by the Cooperative from all members. Therefore, each member who lived during the entire year of **2024** is eligible to claim **10.28%** of their total carrying charges paid as a deduction on their income taxes and/or as a credit for the Homestead Property Taxes paid on your behalf. The following formula is to be used to determine the amount of deduction if you lived in the Cooperative for part of the year or did not pay all your carrying charges assessed in **2024**.

*Carrying charges paid in 2024 are defined by the IRS as only carrying charges payments that you directly made. Do not include membership fees, late charges, and repairs charges paid. Payment made by outside parties on your behalf (HUD or MSHDA) are also not allowed. Use only portion you paid directly for carrying charges each month in this calculation.

Members who have not missed any payment for 2024, or were not receiving subsidy, may use the chart below to calculate your applicable tax deduction.

Directions

- Prepare the Pudding with the Milk add the Peppermint Essence *OPTIONAL* and the Food coloring, mix only until well combined (over mixing will interfere with the setting of the pudding).
- 2. Layer the Pudding and the crumbled Oreo Cookies as you wish.
- 3. Enjoy!

- 8 ounces cream cheese 1 block
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup mayonnaise
- ¹⁄₂ cup Thousand Island Dressing
- 1 cup sauerkraut drained and all juice pressed out
- 2 cups corned beef chopped (from deli section at the grocery store)
- 2 cups Swiss cheese grated

Directions

- 1. Heat oven to 400 degrees.
- 2. In a medium sized bowl, mix together cream cheese, mayonnaise, and thousand island dressing. Add in sauerkraut, corned beef, cheese, and stir. Spoon mixture into a greased ovenproof baking pan. Cook for 15 to 20 minutes until hot and bubbly.
- 3. Enjoy!
